CORRUGATED BOX

Corrugated box or Corrugated Universal box comes in varied paper qualities and thickness ranging from 3ply to 9ply. It is one of the most standardized form of packaging used in multiple industries globally. These boxes can be customized as per consumer size as well as printing requirement.



PRINTED CARTONS

Mostly used to pack small articles, Printed cartons are go-to form of paper packaging if your product is light in weight and doesn't require corrugation. Printed Cartons are extensively used by Pharmaceutical companies and food product manufacturers. Customers usually prefer multi-color offset printing on their cartons to make their packaging more appealing to the final consumers.



CORRUGATED ROLL

corrugated rolls or 2ply roll is a form of packaging which is preferred by customers who doesn't have a fixed dimension for their product. Corrugated roll are a form of flexible packaging mostly used by glass/ wooden article manufacturers or furniture manufacturers.



CORRUGATED SHEETS

For any box to be manufactured firstly a sheet is to be made and then its is finally formed into a box as per client's requirement. Customers use Corrugated sheets mostly as a separator between two products and the thickness can range from 3ply till 11ply depending upon the weight of the product.



DIE-CUT-BOXES

Die-Cut Boxes or Folding Cartons are usually smaller in size as compared to regular corrugated Universal boxes. Folding boxes are designed in a way that it can pack the product without any help of gluing, pinning or duct tape. Once the customer gets a hang of how to form the box then its is the most convenient and affordable form of packaging.



HEAVY DUTY BOXES

Heavy Duty Boxes are usually bigger in size and mostly one box is placed over one pallet. If the product to be packed weighs more than 500Kg then these sort of corrugated boxes are preferred. These boxes usually have flaps on the bottom side and a tray type cap on the other side. Paper quality with higher GSM and Bursting Factor and thickness ranging from 7ply to 11ply are used to withstand the product weight.



E- FLUTE CARTONS

In paper corrugation there are multiple flute types like A,B,C,D and E. E-flute board thickness is usually 1.5 mm and is used for forming smaller size boxes. Only difference between a non-corrugated printed carton and E-Flute Carton is that the customers want both strength of a corrugated box and beauty of a printed carton. These cartons are usually wanted by hardware products or Ceramic article manufacturers because there products are both heavier in weight as well as in requirement of good branding.



HDPE LAMINATED CARTOONS

Raj Packers take pride in development and introduction of HDPE laminated boxes to the packaging industry. With top layer as HDPE these boxes are waterproof and are the most rigid kind of corrugated boxes. These boxes have immense damage with holding capacity. It is recommended that if the product is heavy and is being manhandled in transportation then we should go for these boxes.
